- Assistance: Our logistics team will be on hand to support you throughout the event.



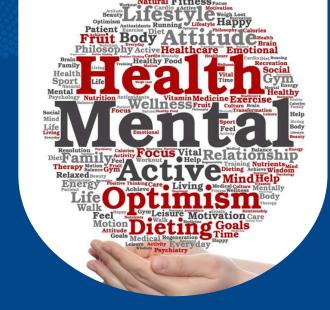

## Exhibition Security Guidelines – Do's and Don'ts During Build up

- X Do not bring portable and easily stolen property until the latest possible time.
- ✓ Keep an eye on personal possessions such as cameras, video recorders, and wallets.
- X Do not leave the stand unattended while setting up or leave portable items lying around.
- Lockers are available at the lower-level entrance to P3 parking.

### **During Exhibition**

- Exhibitors have free access to the exhibition 15 minutes before opening each day.
- Be mindful of maintenance workers, cleaners, and delivery personnel during this time.
- Secure small exhibits, handbags, and cameras to prevent loss.
- Store small exhibits out of sight after closing time.
- Always check your stand before leaving.

#### Break-Down Period

- Remove all portable goods, including video equipment and furniture, immediately after the exhibition closes.
- X Do not leave anything behind.
- X A locked office is not a sufficient protection method, as contractors will need access for quick breakdowns.
- Ensure someone stays on your stand until all your property has been removed.

### **Delivery and Collection of Goods & Exhibits**

- The organizers will not take delivery of any goods on behalf of an exhibitor.
- The organizers are not responsible for any lost or damaged items delivered to the venue.
- Exhibitor must check in at reception upon arrival to ensure neccessary access to the exhibition area.

### **Deliveries During the Exhibition**

- Deliveries must be completed at least 30 minutes before the exhibition opens each day.
- Entry for deliveries is only allowed with an exhibitor badge.

#### Collection

• Exhibitors must schedule collections in advance to avoid delays

### Cleaning & Refuse Removal

- Exhibitors must keep their stands clean at all times.
- Waste should be placed in aisle bins at the close of each exhibition day.
- Cleaning contractors will not enter exhibitor stands.
- The organizers will provide general venue cleaning but not individual stands.
- Exhibitors expecting heavy waste production should notify the venue at least one week before the event.

### Insurance of Your Goods on Exhibition

- Exhibitors must ensure that their displayed goods and personal belongings (e.g., cameras) are covered under their own insurance policy.
- Venue security will be present during the day and dedicated security may be appointed for nighttime coverage.

- 2.Compliance: Exhibitors must comply with all local laws, regulations, and venue policies.
- 3.Insurance: Exhibitors are advised to carry appropriate insurance coverage for their exhibits and staff.
- 4.Cancellation Policy: Any cancellations must be communicated in writing at least 30 days before the event. No refunds will be issued for late cancellations.
